

Political opinion polls in Belgium 1974 - 1989

Index of keywords and references

Since 1974 each Political Yearbook of Res Publica comprises an annual overview of public opinion polls in Belgium. An index of keywords now makes information on more than 800 opinion polls readily accessible. The index was compiled by Erwin Das, assistant at the Section of Political Sociology of the University of Leuven, relying on *Steunpunt socio-politieke systeem : De politieke opiniepeilingen in België 1974-1989*, Gent, 1991, 240 p., which is mainly based on the overviews of Res Publica.

How to use the index?

Keywords are followed by places of publication of relevant public opinion polls : year of publication, issue and page numbers in Res Publica.

Each reference in the annual overview contains a short summary (list of the main topics), public opinion polling institute, time of polling, size and type of the sample, number of questions, client and bibliographical data.
